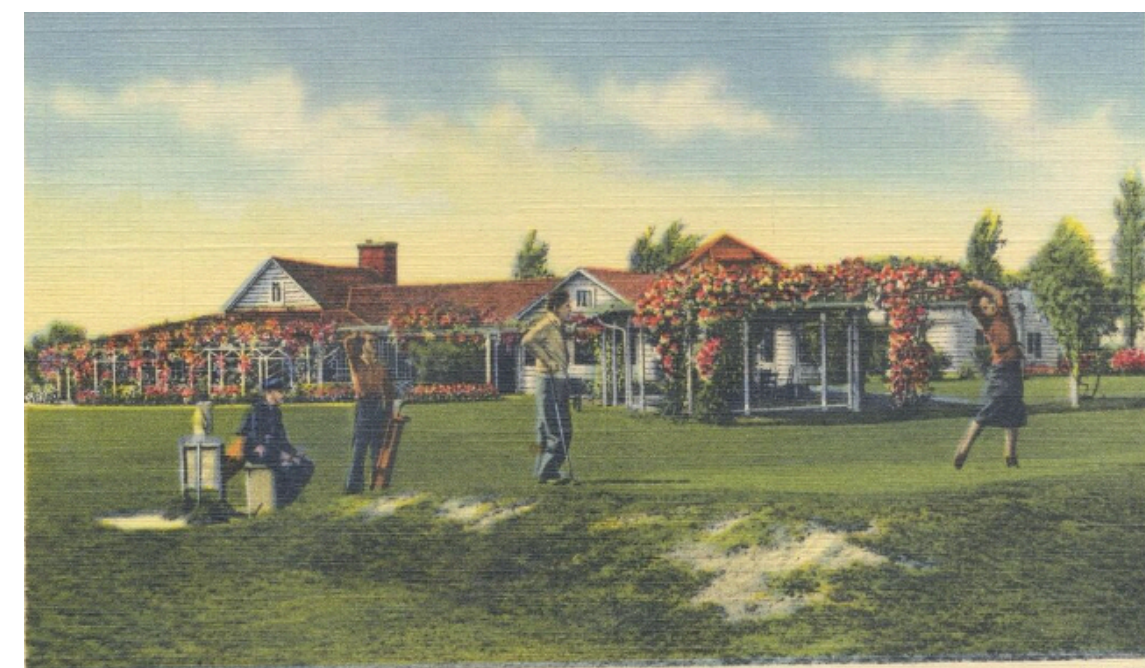

Two Weeks Prior

- Notify Excelsior Springs Golf Club on final number of players
- Provide player list
- Final number of meals needed
- Notify any changes in rules
- Special requirements (circle on green, multiple holes, line in fairway, proximity markers, etc.)

Day Before

- Gift bags
- Name changes of teams (if any)
- Scorecards with names and starting holes
- Sign in sheets
- Any additional supplies

Day of Event

- Notify volunteers/staff of course policies
- Bring method of payment
- Cash box or money bag for any volunteers assigned to special event holes
- Sponsor volunteers
- Special event volunteers
- Bring supplies (pens, paper, tape, markers)
- Hole sponsor signs
- Updated player list
- Prizes and tee gifts
- Raffle tickets (if applicable)
